COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

- BI 241 Psalm in Lectionary - Luker
Translation and exegesis of the weekly Psalm appointed in the lectionary. Foci will be spiritual formation and application to preaching and teaching. Special attention to reading the Psalm in the context of the other three appointed lessons for the week. MARs may take the course and work from the English text.
- CM 239 Exegetical Options for the Preacher
Students will explore and participate in three exegetical options for the preacher. The three options include Long's brief exegetical method, Gross' hermeneutical journey report and Allen's conversational homiletic for the congregation. This course requires preparation of exegetical papers and in-class delivery of sermons. Class limited to 24.
- CM 550 Counseling and Leadership in Family and Church Systems - McKay
- HT 454 Spanish
An introduction to the use of the Spanish language in ministry. The course will focus on basic conversational skills, the liturgy in Spanish, and the use of Spanish in various pastoral situations. No previous knowledge of Spanish is presumed.
